The Malbork Castle Museum invites all interested parties to participate in the international scientific conference: "*Wisdom has built her house... The Teutonic Order and its state in Medieval Prussia*", which will be held in Malbork (Poland), between 15th and 17th November 2019.

Proposals for conference presentations may include issues regarding:

- the history of the Teutonic Order in the Middle Ages
- the process of settling of the Teutonic Order in the Baltic Sea region and the conquest of Prussia
- the creation of the Teutonic Order's state and its medieval history
- the history of art and culture in the Teutonic Order's state during the Middle Ages
- construction methods and architecture of the Teutonic Order's state
- the role and importance of cities in the Teutonic Order's state
- trade and economy in the Teutonic Order's state
- diplomacy and war
- religious life in the State of the Teutonic Order

Please note that this list is not exhaustive, and other topics concerning the subject matter may be accepted. We therefore invite all interested parties to submit proposals for presentations regarding other issues concerning the functioning of the State of the Teutonic Order in the Baltic Sea region.

The language used during the conference will be Polish or English (simultaneous translation will be provided by the Organiser). The printing of materials is planned post-conference.

We invite all those interested in delivering a 20 minutes presentation to submit their proposals for topics, along with a short summary (no more than 100 words), 5 keywords and a biographical note about the author, including information on their affiliation, contact details (e-mail, phone) and a brief description of their research.
